General Participant Code of Conduct

We encourage parents and guardians to review and discuss the General Participant Code of Conduct with each of their children participating in this program.

- Never use foul language.
- Always listen to recreation department staff and volunteers with respect.
- Respect all facilities and equipment of the Rocky Hill Parks & Recreation Department and Rocky Hill schools.
- Tobacco use and alcohol are prohibited on Rocky Hill recreational facilities and at agency sanctioned events.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Control your temper and use good judgment.

Consequences: When a participant's behavior is deemed inappropriate, he or she will be dealt with using the appropriate form of discipline according to the Parks & Recreation Departmental policies. If expulsion from the program occurs, all program fees will be forfeited. No refunds available.

ROCKY HILL PARKS & RECREATION
Player Code of Conduct

We encourage each parent and guardian to review and discuss the Player Code of Conduct with each of their children participating in this program.

- Play by and adhere to the rules.
- Value safety, fair play, and welfare above personal prestige and gain.
- Accept the authority of all game officials.
- Never argue with officials. If you disagree, have your captain, approach the umpire during a break or after the match.
- Never use abusive or foul language.
- Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players, deliberately distracting or picking on opponents is not an acceptable or permitted behavior in any sport.
- Be a good sport. Applaud all good play, whether by team mates or opposition.
- Treat all participants in your sport as you would like to be treated.
- Always co-operate with your coach and team mates and also with your opposition, as without them there would be no competition.
- Always participate for your own enjoyment and benefit, not just to please parents, other persons or coaches.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Tobacco use and alcohol are prohibited on Rocky Hill Parks & Recreation facilities and at agency sanctioned events.

Consequences: When a child's behavior is deemed inappropriate, they will be dealt with using the appropriate form of discipline ranging from timeouts, the program director or parent being notified, to suspension or expulsion from participating in the program. If expulsion from the program occurs, all program fees will be forfeited. No refunds available.

Spectator Code of Conduct

We encourage all parents and spectators to review the Spectator Code of Conduct prior to the start of any program.

- Appreciate that people participate in sport for their enjoyment and benefit, not necessarily yours.
- Respect the decision of officials and encourage players to do so.
- Applaud good performance and efforts from all individuals and the team.
- Congratulate all players on their performance regardless of the outcome.
- Never ridicule players for making mistakes. Positive comments are motivational.
- Condemn the use of violence in any form, whether it is by other spectators, coaches, officials or players.
- Show respect for your teams opponents. Without there would be no game.
- Encourage all players to follow the rules and official's decisions.
- Do not use foul language, sledge or harass players, coaches or officials.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person, regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background of religion.
- Tobacco use and alcohol are prohibited on Rocky Hill Parks & Recreation facilities.
- **Consequences:** If a spectator's behavior is deemed inappropriate, they may be asked by a coach or official to leave the premises. If this behavior continues, the department director will speak with the spectator and ask them not to attend the program. Such incidents will be recorded through an incident report form and tracked by the department director.

- Show respect for your team's opponents. Without them there would be no game.
- Encourage all players to follow the rules and official's decisions.
- Do not use foul language, sledge or harass players, coaches or officials.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person, regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Tobacco use and alcohol are prohibited on Rocky Hill Parks & Recreation facilities.
- **Consequences:** If a coach's behavior is deemed inappropriate, they may be asked by a field supervisor or official to leave the premises. If this behavior continues the program supervisor will speak with the coach and may remove him/her from the program. Such incidents will be recorded through an incident report form and tracked by the program supervisor.
